Throughout the school day all students are given many opportunities to be rewarded positively for making good choices.

- Accept Responsibility
- Will Participate in Learning

- Stay in Control of your Words & Actions

The above is a sample of our HIGH FIVE reward.

HIGH FIVES are given to students when they are 'caught' making good choices. Students will save their HIGH FIVES and each Friday they will have the choice to either: 1) spend their HIGH FIVES, 2) spend some of their HIGH FIVES while also saving some, or 3) save all of their HIGH FIVES for a later date and possibly a larger reward.

The Hawkeye General Store will be open each Friday. There will be items to purchase with their earned HIGH FIVES. (If your child is absent on Friday their next opportunity to shop will be the following Friday).

## Individual Classrooms:

Students will be rewarded within the classroom by their teacher. Some examples of positive behavior to be rewarded include:

- completed homework
- sitting in seat
- participating in class
- keeping their hands to themselves

As the teacher rewards the student with their earned HIGH FIVE they will also state their positive behavior and the HAWKS Expectation demonstrated.

## Common Areas:

Common areas include: hallways, bathrooms, cafeteria, bus ramp, parent pick-up area and the playground.

Administrators, faculty and staff will also be rewarding students demonstrating positive behavior while in or on these areas. Some examples of positive behavior to be rewarded include:

- walking quietly
- clean up after yourself
- practice personal hygiene
- follow directions
- keep hand, feet and objects to yourself

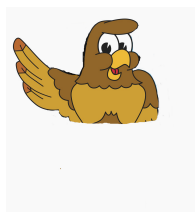
## An Introduction to the Hartsfield Elementary School-Wide Positive Behavior Support System

## What is Positive Behavior Support or PBS?

Hartsfield HIGH FIVE Positive Behavior Support is acknowledging students when they demonstrate positive behavior. Hartsfield HIGH FIVE PBS is a school-wide program and involves *all staff and students*. Positive behavior will increase *academic achievement*. There will be less time dealing with disruptive behavior providing more time to teach and learn!

The Hartsfield HIGH FIVE program has very clear expectations for all areas of the school. Posters will be displayed as reminders and to assist parents, guardians, and visitors of the expectations of our students and staff.

## Expectations and Rules Matrix

Hartsfield Elementary School has five (5) expectations for our students and staff to follow. Along with the expectations are rules that were developed to help reinforce the expectations.

## Hartsfield's Hawks Expectations

*Have respect*

*Accept responsibility*

*Will participate in learning*

*Keep Hartsfield safe and clean*

*Stay in control of your words and actions*

Each common area has a set of five(5) rules. Some of these rules are duplicated from one area to the other. An example, 'follow directions' can be stated for the cafeteria, playground, bus and parent pick-up area.

Individual classrooms have also developed rules that support our Hawks Expectations.

## Hawks Rules

### Cafeteria Rules

- Use positive words
- Clean up after yourself
- Follow directions
- Walk at all times
- Use table voice

### Hall/Transition Rules

- Walk quietly
- Pick up after yourself and others
- Go directly to designated area only
- Walk at all times
- Maintain personal space

### Playground Rules

- Be kind to others
- Tell the truth
- Follow directions
- Use playground equipment appropriately
- Keep hands and feet to yourself

### Restroom Rules

- Transition quietly
- Clean up bathroom area
- Use time wisely
- Practice personal hygiene
- Use restroom for intended purpose

### Parent Pick-up/Bus Area Rules

- Use positive words
- Remain calm
- Follow directions
- Remain stationary and alert
- Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself
