The School Public Accountability Report includes important information about Hartsfield Elementary School, which includes, kindergarten readiness, FCAT test scores, and enrollment. We are proud of our accomplishments this past year. We had a 7-point increase in the number of students making learning gains in math, a 5-point increase in the number of students scoring 3 and above on the FCAT science, and our students in the lowest 25% had a 21-point increase in their FCAT math. Our success is due to our highly qualified, dedicated teachers, the hard work of our students and staff, and the support and involvement of our parents, volunteers, mentors, partners, and the Hartsfield Community.

At Hartsfield we truly believe that every child can learn and our teachers go above and beyond.
